



# Honduras 2017

## Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

- Place: Tegucigalpa, Honduras
- Dates: Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> - Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup> (7 days, 6 nights)
- Cost: **\$1,100-\$1,200** (to be finalized) - Covers airfare, all ground transportation to/from airport and in-country, 15 meals, 6 nights lodging, travel insurance, t-shirt. *Not* included: routine immunizations, vaccinations, 6 meals, and souvenirs.
- A **\$300 non-refundable** deposit by Dec 31<sup>st</sup> (2016) will secure a position on the team, along with an online application form (one per team member). Additional installments are due by the following 2017 deadlines: **\$300** by Feb 26<sup>th</sup>, **\$300** by April 23<sup>rd</sup>, with final **(\$200-\$300)** balance due May 11<sup>th</sup>.
- Missionary / Host: Bill & Mary Strickland / Centro Evangelistico de las Asambleas de Dios (CEAD)

- Requirements:
- \* If 14-17 years of age, can be with accompaniment *or* approval of legal guardian. If under 14 years of age, must be with accompaniment of legal guardian.
  - \* Must attend team meetings on **Sunday, Apr. 23<sup>rd</sup>** and **Thursday, May 11<sup>th</sup>**
  - \* Must participate in any team fundraising efforts
  - \* Must submit all paperwork (application, medical, insurance, liability)
  - \* Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip
- Opportunity: CEAD purchased a 120-acre tract of land north of Tegucigalpa in the early 2000s, and has planted two very effective ministries at this camp: (1) Teen Challenge – a drug and alcohol rehab program for adult and adolescent males serving ~100; and (2) Casa Hogar – a group-home style orphanage geared to elementary-aged children, serving ~40. We will return to this location to serve both of these entities through ministry, social interaction, and humanitarian aid. We will visit and participate in services at the vibrant CEAD church in Tegucigalpa, also ministering in various outreach venues of the church as invited. We will stay *onsite* at the camp for our 6 nights in Honduras, immersing ourselves in these ministries and helping them advance, even as our own lives are changed.
- Health & Safety: We will follow guidelines to ensure the safety of team members at all times, in cooperation with CEAD personnel at Teen Challenge and Casa Hogar.
- There are no required travel vaccinations, but team members should be current on all routine immunizations and should consider CDC recommendations ([http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/mission\\_disaster/honduras](http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/mission_disaster/honduras)) for vaccinations that could be helpful in Honduras.
