## Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

**Place:** Yurimaguas, Peru

**Dates:** Friday, May 22 – Saturday, May 30, 2026

**Cost:** **\$2,700** – Trip cost covers airfare, baggage fees, in-country transportation, lodging, travel insurance, team t-shirt, and most meals. *Not* included: immunizations, souvenirs, and some meals.

A **\$500 non-refundable** deposit by **January 25<sup>th</sup>** secures a spot on the team, along with an online application (per team member). Additional installments are due by the following deadlines: **\$500** by **February 22<sup>nd</sup>**, **\$500** by **March 31<sup>st</sup>**, with final balance of **\$1,200** due **April 28<sup>th</sup>**.

**Requirements:**

- \* If under 16 years of age, you may participate if a parent or legal guardian is also a part of the team. If 16-17 years of age, you can participate without a parent or legal guardian, if a temporary guardian (adult) on the team is authorized.
- \* Team members must attend 2 team meetings: **Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>** and **Tuesday, April 28<sup>th</sup>** (both at 7:00 pm at Kingwood Church).
- \* Must submit all paperwork (application, insurance, waivers, health forms, etc.).
- \* Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip.

**Opportunity:** We will return to the Amazon Basin of Peru to work with Ricky & Carol Hendon, Alabama missionaries who serve this remote region with a threefold focus: (1) planting and building churches in unreached tribal communities, (2) training indigenous pastors and church leaders for ministry (in a training center in Ullpayaco where a Kingwood took a team in 2017), and (3) operating Camp Yuri (located in Yurimaguas, the town where they are based), a camp they founded and have led the ongoing construction of since 2018. Our exact work project for 2026, still to be determined, will be in one of these 3 focal points.

**Health & Safety:** We will follow guidelines to always ensure the safety of team members, in cooperation with missionary and church personnel.

- \* Peru has no requirement for COVID vaccination, testing, or quarantine.
