Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

Place: Brussels, Belgium

Friday, November 13 – Saturday, November 21, 2026



Cost: **\$2,000** – Trip cost covers airfare, baggage fees, in-country transportation, lodging, travel insurance, team t-shirt, and most meals. *Not included:* immunizations, souvenirs, and some meals.

A **\$500 non-refundable** deposit by **June 21st** (or when team is full, whichever comes first) secures a spot on the team, along with an online application (per team member). Additional installments are due by the following deadlines: **\$500** by **August 16th**, **\$500** by **September 22nd**, with final **\$500** due by **October 20th**.

Missionary Host: *John & Shawn Alderman*

Requirements:

- * If under 16 years of age, you may participate if a parent or legal guardian is also a part of the team. If 16-17 years of age, you can participate without a parent or legal guardian, if a temporary guardian (adult) on the team is authorized.
- * Team members must attend 2 team meetings: **Tuesday, September 22nd** and **Tuesday, October 20th** (both at 7:00 pm at Kingwood Church).
- * Must submit all paperwork (application, insurance, waivers, health forms, etc.).
- * Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip.

Opportunity: Continental Theological Seminary (CTS) is one of the leading training institutions in the world preparing the next generation of Spirit-empowered church leaders who will engage the secular landscape of post-Christian Europe. Our team will work to renovate a historic building on campus for expansion of key priorities in training future leaders. We will stay on campus and enjoy meals, fellowship, and chapel services with students as we work to advance this institution. We will also partner with the Aldermans to serve Breaking Chains Network, a ministry bringing hope and healing to victims of human trafficking and sexual exploitation.
