Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

Place:	Tegucigalpa, Honduras
Dates:	Tuesday, June 4 - Monday, June 10, 2019
Cost:	\$1,300 - Covers airfare, all ground transportation to/from airport and within Honduras, 15 meals, 6 nights lodging, travel insurance, t-shirt. <i>Not</i> included: routine immunizations, recommended vaccinations, 6 meals, and souvenirs.
	A \$400 <i>non-refundable</i> deposit by <u>Dec. 31st</u> (2018) will secure a position on the team, along with an online application form (one per team member). Additional installments are due by the following deadlines: \$300 by <u>Feb 10th</u> , \$300 by <u>April 7th</u> , with final \$300 balance due <u>May 9th</u> .

Requirements:	 * If 14-17 years of age, can be with accompaniment <i>or</i> approval of legal guardian. If under 14 years of age, must be with accompaniment of legal guardian. * Must attend team meetings on Sunday, April 7th and Thursday, May 9th * Must participate in any team fundraising efforts * Must submit all paperwork (application, medical, insurance, liability) * Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip
Opportunity:	CEAD purchased a 120-acre tract of land north of Tegucigalpa in the early 2000s, and has planted three very effective ministries at this camp: (1) Camp CEAD – a place used year-round by the church for powerful spiritual retreats; (2) Teen Challenge – a drug and alcohol rehab program for adult and adolescent males serving ~100; and (3) Casa Hogar – a group-home style orphanage geared to elementary-aged children, serving ~60. We will serve Camp CEAD through dormitory construction, while having numerous daily opportunities for ministry, social interaction, and humanitarian aid. We will also visit and participate in services at the vibrant CEAD church in Tegucigalpa. We will stay <i>onsite</i> at the camp for our 6 nights in Honduras, immersing ourselves in these ministries and helping them advance, even as our own lives are changed.
Health & Safety:	We will follow guidelines to ensure the safety of team members at all times, in cooperation with CEAD personnel at Teen Challenge and Casa Hogar. There are no required travel vaccinations, but team members should be current
	on all routine immunizations and should consider CDC recommendations (http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/mission_disaster/honduras) for vaccinations that could be helpful in Honduras.
