

Two times each year (early June and mid-November), Kingwood Church takes missions teams all over the world. These trips generally consist of a construction / renovation project, evangelism, and humanitarian efforts. Our teams vary from 15 to 50 members in size, depending on the project. No matter the experiences and skill levels people have, they can find a productive role on one of our teams.

Not only are our teams open to men and women, but at least one trip each year is open to families. Youth (ages 14-17, with parental consent) and children (as young as age 8, if accompanied by a parent) are welcome to be part of these family-friendly trips. Meaningful opportunities are provided for children and youth to make a contribution to these teams.

The cost and length of foreign trips varies by locale. Typically, Central American trips cost in the range of \$1,200 - \$1,500 per person. European and South American trips typically range from \$2,000 - \$2,500 per person. Trips to Asia or Africa will normally fall in the \$2,500 - \$3,000 per person range. The greater the travel involved, the longer the trip will be. Our shortest foreign trips last 7-8 days, and our longest trips last 11-13 days and typically take place in November (occurring just prior to Thanksgiving).

Periodically, we also offer a domestic trip to work on a missions project in another state. These trips are the most accessible to families due to being less expensive (typically \$500 - \$750 per person) and not involving flights, passports, or vaccinations. Domestic trips typically last 7-9 days, depending on travel.

Trip sign-up becomes available 6-9 months before trips take place, and closes at least 3 months before trip departure to allow time for all necessary trip preparations to take place.
