Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

- Place:** Fortaleza, Brazil (northeastern coast along Atlantic Ocean)
- Dates:** Sunday, November 15th - Wednesday, November 25th (11 days, 10 nights)
- Host:** Assembleia de Deus Agua Vida (Living Water Assembly of God)
- Opportunity:** This trip is for men and women who will be at least 18 years of age as of November 15th. There are 22 spaces available on this team. We will be working with a Brazilian pastor who is the brother of Kingwood's own Newton Pereira. The church (Agua Vida) has and grown established multiple "daughter campuses" outside Fortaleza. One of these church plants has been given a facility that is well-located but in need of construction and renovation work to become fully usable as a permanent location for that campus. We will stay and work in that area, enjoying the beachside location along the Atlantic Ocean. For the free day, we will visit Rio de Janeiro, one of the most beautiful and iconic cities in the world.
- Cost:** **\$2,000** - Covers international and domestic airfares, all ground transportation to/from airport and ground transportation in-country, most meals, all nights lodging, travel insurance, t-shirt. *Not included:* routine immunizations, any vaccinations, a few travel/free day meals, and souvenirs.
- A **\$500 non-refundable** deposit by April 5th will secure a position on the team, along with an online application form (one per team member). Additional installments are due by the following deadlines: **\$500** by June 14th, **\$500** by August 13th, with final (**\$500**) balance due October 22nd.
- Requirements:**
- * Must attend team meetings on **Thursday, Aug. 13th** and **Thursday, Oct. 22nd**
 - * Must participate in any team fundraising efforts
 - * Must submit all paperwork (application, medical, insurance, liability)
 - * Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip
- Health & Safety:** We will follow the pastor's and AGWM's guidelines to ensure our safety.
- There are no required travel vaccinations, but team members should be current on all routine immunizations and should consider CDC recommendations (<https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/brazil>) for vaccinations and meds that could be helpful in Brazil. We will not be visiting remote areas.
