



Missions Trip - Fact Sheet

- Place:** Newport, Cocke County (East Tennessee)
- Dates:** Sunday, May 30 – Saturday, June 5, 2021
- Cost:** **\$600** - Covers all ground transportation to/from and within Tennessee, most meals, 6 nights lodging, and team t-shirt. *Not* included in cost: routine immunizations / meds, souvenirs, and any optional/free day excursions.
- A \$100 *non-refundable* deposit by Weds., March 31st will secure a position on the team, along with an application form (one per team member). Additional installments will be due by Sun., April 25th (\$250) and Sun., May 23rd (\$250).

- Requirements:**
- * If 14-17 years of age, can be with accompaniment *or* approval of legal guardian. If under 14 years of age, must be with accompaniment of legal guardian.
 - * Must attend any team meetings / fundraisers / prayer times
 - * Must submit all paperwork (application, medical, insurance, liability)
 - * Must be accountable to abide by all team rules during trip
- Lodging:** We will stay in hotel style rooms (2-4 per room) at the Mountain House Inn in downtown Gatlinburg, and commute daily (~1 hour each way) to the worksite.
- Opportunity:** The Smoky Mountain Dream Center (SMDC) is a faith-based nonprofit organization ministering to the unique needs of Appalachia. Led by Keith and Alicia Hall (who are products of Kingwood Church) and their team, SMDC offers transitional housing and Christ-centered solutions to women who have faced incarceration, a church facility for the community, and youth and children leadership programs to aid in their physical, mental, and spiritual development. SMDC has launched into the first phase of developing a permanent housing facility on new property. We will engage as a team in a combination of work projects and ministry with women, youth, and children. **Team size limit is 30.**
- Health & Safety:** We will follow guidelines to ensure the safety of team members at all times, in accordance with the instructions of SMDC personnel.
- There are no required travel vaccinations, as this is a domestic trip. Temperatures in east Tennessee in early June should be slightly cooler than summer in Alabama.
