

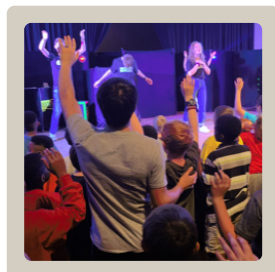
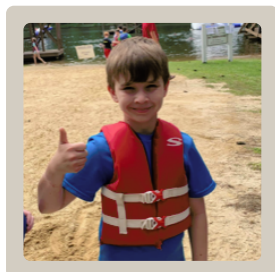
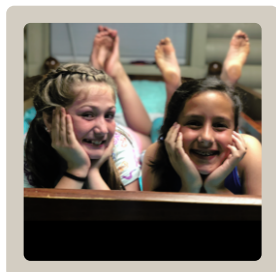
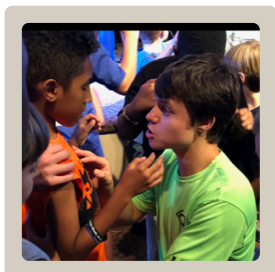
# KIDS CAMP

## MEDICATION

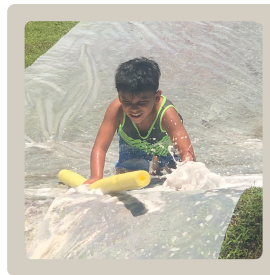
If your child needs to take medication during camp, you can fill out at Medication Form at drop off. There is also a camp nurse.
